But conditions for the run was far from perfect, high winds, rain and hail greeted the runners, and presentations at The Guide Inn were briefly interrupted by a powercut.

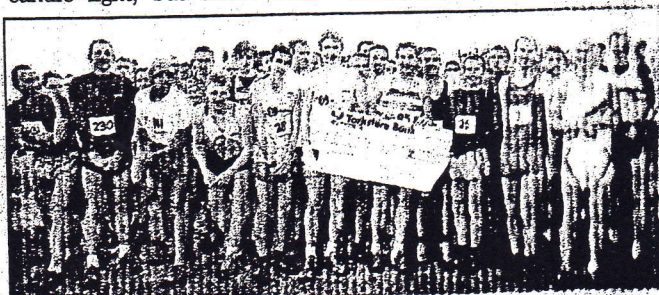
"We managed to continue by candle light, but there were

Salford's Anne Buckley, twice a winner in the 90's beat K&C's Helen Glover by 19 seconds to win in 23:08 with Thalia Jones of Holmefrith third and 1st U-16 in 23:42.
