Brownlee sets Withins record

WORLD junior triathalon champion Alastair Brownlee won the 15th annual Withins Skyline Fell Race on Sunday but there were some good performances by Keighley area runners.

A total of 277 senior runners took part in the seven-mile race, which visits Oxenhope Stoop, the top of Withins, Bronte Bridge before a scramble up Bronte Waterfalls.

Brownlee, a Cambridge University student who runs for Bingley Harriers, set a new course record while leading all the way chased by Adam Osborne of Leeds City AC and 2004 winner John Heneghan of Pudsey & Bramley AC. Keighley & Craven AC's top runner was Chris Loftus, finishing eight overall. Last week's Beefs Nab winner, Paul Crabtree, also of Keighley & Craven, finished in 23rd place.

UK Fell Inter-county winner Jo Waites, won the lady's race, setting a new course record on her 35th birthday. The 2003 ladies winner, Jo Buckley of Harden Moor, who runs for Wharfedale AC, finished second and Silsden's Tamara Hird was third.

Junior England team manager Vashir Hussain finished fifth overall and was first in the V40 section with Bradford man Steve Oldfield winning the V50 trophy. Oldfield won the overall race in 2002 and and V40 trophy six times in the past.

A massive 105 juniors contested the quarry run with Thomas Sessford of Silsden winning the U-14s race. Phil Done the U-10s race and Rosie Helliwell, the girls U-12s race. All three run for Keighley & Craven.

Organiser David Woodhead, the race winner in 1993, said it was good having Brownlee take part in the race.

"He was slightly embarrassed with all the attention. People were asking him to sign autographs and we presented him with a big cake embossed with a picture of him waving the England flag when he won the world championships in Switzerland."

He also said that having 37 U-8s taking part shows that "if you put events on for them, they will compete".
