Silver was the colour of the day for our Yorkshire teams in the British U17 & U19 Inter County Fell Running Championships at the Clougha Pike Fell Races on Saturday 22nd June 2019 from Quernmore in the Trough of Bowland Lancashire.

In the FU17 race Lilli Carr 4th, Lexi Whitaker 5th & Betty Bergstrand 6th gave great packing for the team to win Silver medals, with North Wales winning Gold and Scotland Central the Bronze medals. Individual Champion was Anna Hedley of Scotland Central who runs for Fife AC and won the Bronze medal in the Inter County XC Championships and finished third FU17 in the Virgin Mini London Marathon earlier in the year, showing how competitive these Fell Running Championships are becoming.

In the MU17 race Eric Beaumont 4th, Sam Headley 7th and Alexander Thompson 9th were rewarded with Championship Team Silver medals, with Derbyshire taking the Gold and Lancashire the Bronze medals. Individual Champion was Will Longden of Derbyshire who finished 3rd in the Derbyshire XC Championships.

In the FU19 race Emily Jones 6th, Emily Field 7th and although Katie Atkinson had to retire injured, the women still finished with fantastic team Silver medals just beating North Wales on count back, whilst Lancashire took Team Gold and Individual Gold with Lancashire XC Champion Finty Royle.

In the MU19 race Sebastian Segger-Staveley 13th, Jack Walton 14th and William Thompson 22nd meant Yorkshire finished outside the medals in 4th place, where North Wales took Gold, Lancashire Silver and Derbyshire the Bronze Team medals. Individual Champion was Matthew Knowles of Lancashire.
